



Our Club:

The Great Southern Street Machine Association Inc is a not for profit sporting club for motoring enthusiasts and their families. The club has been operating for over 30 years in our community.

Currently we have over eighty members. Members meet once a month for a sausage sizzle, catch up with everyone and a meeting. Club runs are held each month varying from golf days, trips to wineries, poker runs and trips to motoring shows. This year has been a bit different, with all the restrictions happening we were not able to hold our meetings or club runs as normal. We welcomed online meetings and virtual club runs which was successful in keeping our club going and our members engaged.

We also hold grass roots motorsport events throughout the year examples of which events we have conducted are, Racewars Pendeen sprint, Motorsport Australia (CAMS) speed event Series Wind Farm Hill Climb, Pendeen Sprint, our Show & Shine weekend we hold a Motorsport Australia (CAMS) speed event and/or motorkhana. We also travel to neighbouring towns to help their local clubs to conduct motorsport events. This year we were the first Motorsport Australia (CAMS) competitive event in WA post COVID-19.

The events we conduct require officials, with our strategic plan of training courses over the past years we can deliver all officials positions for the events we convene. This is an ongoing plan; we hold several Motorsport Australia (CAMS) training courses a year. The practical training is via events we conduct and events from neighbouring venues.

We are highly active in the local community, supporting local motoring events, around the houses, Racewars, TARGA West, Cars & Coffee, Operation Rudolf, City of Albany Christmas pageant, we provide displays, event volunteers, officials, entrants, and spectators. We also support local charities.

The annual Show & Shine is the high light of the year for the community and our club. It has been running for the past 24 years and each year it gets bigger. From humble beginnings to what we have achieved in the past couple of years, an in-door Show & Shine. Spread over two large pavilions and surrounding ovals there is plenty to see and do for the whole family.
