

## FURTHER REGULATIONS.

Notice as of 16 May 2020 for all competitors, officials and attendees at the Weekend of Speed events- May 30<sup>th</sup> to the 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020

**RATIONALE:** Given recent developments in the fight to contain Coronavirus (Covid 19) within the State of Western Australia, the Great Southern Street Machine Association Inc. has, with the issue of these further regulations, demonstrated its desire to ensure the safety of all attendees at the Weekend of Speed in Albany W.A. in accordance with the relevant stage 2 prohibitions as required to permit operation of the event in the State of Western Australia.

**REGULATIONS.** It is incumbent upon all attending the event familiarise themselves and comply with **all** of the requirements outlined in the Government of WA Phase 2 prohibitions, details are available [HERE](#). This is a living document and updated regularly.

Furthermore, It is incumbent upon all attending the event familiarise themselves and comply with **all** of the requirements outlined in the Motorsport Australia Covid 19 information documentation available [HERE](#). This is a living document and updates may occur.

Generally, this involves the following basic principals

1. Practice social distancing by maintaining 1.5 meter spacing at all times.
2. Each attendee is to establish a 4 square meter area of there own in the event area and remain in that area.
3. Practice good hygiene. Wash hands regularly, use hand sanitiser, do not share equipment.
4. Do not attend the meeting if you have any symptoms of Covid 19 including a cough, elevated temperature or at all feeling unwell.
5. Avoid contact.
6. Do not assemble in groups.

An advice to competitors, officials and all attendees will be issued by GSSMA Inc. prior to commencement. This will contain specific details of the roles and responsibilities of each attendee.

Prior to attending the event and no earlier than 24 hours prior to commencement, it is a requirement for **all** to text to the GSSMA Inc message service, accessed on the number 0477 562 572, the following

And attest to the following statement:

I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE EVENT REGULATIONS, THESE REGULATION AND ADVICE PROVIDED AND ARE AND WILL MAINTAIN COMPLIANCE WITH ITS REQUIRMENTS.

WITH THE PHRASE **“I am Compliant”**

Upon receipt of this message, you will be permitted entry to the event at the direction of the entry Marshall.
