 Cars must be adequately muffled and comply with the requirements outlined in regulation.
 Competitors must produce a valid and current:
 Motorsport Australia Competition Licence (hardcard and book)
 Motorsport Australia Competition Licence Licences to be checked prior to event electronically
 Club Membership Card of a Motorsport Australia-Affiliated Car Club to be checked prior to event electronically
 Vehicle Logbook (if issued) must be presented at document check.
 Event Organisers, in conjunction with the Chief Scrutineer, will set up suitable facilities to receive Vehicle Log Books from Competitors in a safe and controlled manner at the event

COMPETITION AND CLASSES:

1. STATE CHAMPIONSHIP
2. STATE SPEED EVENT SERIES CHAMPIONSHIP
3. CLUB LEVEL COMPETITION
4. NOVICE COMPETITION (untimed, non-competitive)

- (a) The State Championship competitors will compete in classes & Competition Groups as per the 2020 State championship Hill Climb and Sprint standing regulations respectively
- (b) The Speed event Series competitors will compete in Classes & Competition Groups as per the 2020 Speed Event Series Standing Regulations
- (c) Club level competitors will compete in classes & competition Groups as per the 2020 Motorsport Australia Manual.
- (d) Novice Competition times will not be published and will be conducted as a demonstration for the purposes of come and try.
- (e) No in-person ceremonies can be conducted

TIMING:

- (a) Timing will be to the 100th of a second
- (b) Competitors will be at start controls at regular intervals to be determined by the Starter. Such departures shall be single vehicle starts.
- (c) Provisional results will be available 30 minutes after the last car complete the Event.
- (d) The results will be determined by the Competitor who achieves the lowest single elapsed time (inclusive of penalties) i.e. fastest run in their Class or Competition Group as well as Outright



A detailed list of awards offered for each competition:

- (a) State Championship as per the 2020 State Championship Hill Climb and Sprint Standing Regulations respectively.
- (b) State Speed Event Series as per the 2020 Speed Event Series Standing Regulations.
- (c) Club level a trophy will be presented for the fastest time of the day by a club member for each event.
- (d) Novice competition participants will be presented with a participation certificate

SCHEDULE/ OTHER EVENT REQUIREMENTS:

START/NUMBER OF RUNS:

- (a) Competition will commence at **allocated times**. Each competitor will be allowed one practice run and must **NOT** be driven at full competitive speeds. Practice times do not count for competition results.
- (b) The event proper is scheduled to start immediately following practice. Each competitor shall have a practice run and 4 x timed runs, time permitting
- (c) The Track Licence restricts competition to two vehicles at a time.
- (d) A 30-minute official's lunch break will occur at an appropriate time.
- (e) The event is scheduled to finish at approximately **1600hrs**.

Entries will be accepted in order of receipt including Novice entries.

Alterations to and Nomination of drivers will be accepted at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course at any time.

The organizers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent/ guardian.

Event organizers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA Manual.

ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the Motorsport Australia website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia
